CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

The (Band) agrees to accept as a "condition of entry":

- a) The Associations' and Promoter's right to amend or vary any times as printed in the official "Order of Play,"
- b) To participate in: (i) March Past and Finale Massed Band(s); (ii) be the Duty Band for the Drum Major Contest (Solo) if so rostered by the Association at a specific contest and (iii) if approved, the Official Opening Massed Band(s) {subject to Rule B.1.06.05}. Failure to comply may result in disqualification and/or forfeiture of any prize monies.
- c) The Promoter's right to charge band members' families the normal gate fee. Band personnel must present their gate passes to gain entry to the ground. Passes will be sent direct to the Bands entered by the Promoter concerned and the maximum issued number not to exceed number of registered players at date of entry.
- d) The Associations' and Promoter's right to refuse any entry without giving reason.
- e) Participation in the Street March and/or March Off Drill Contest - where offered - irrespective they do not form part of the aggregate contest for all Grade 4 to 1 bands are compulsory separate contest elements. Failure to participate may result in disqualification and/or the forfeiture of any eligible prize monies.
- f) The consumption of alcohol whilst forming, up for and during massed bands is prohibited until after the massed band has been dismissed by the Senior Drum Major.
- g) The requirements of Rule A.1.08.01 (acceptable behaviour) apply throughout the day of the contest.
- h) Confirms the band is covered for Public Liability Insurance.
- i) Entry fees for entries withdrawn after the closing date for late entries will be forfeited.

MASSED BAND REQUIREMENTS FOR SEASON

Bands are reminded that participation in massed bands is a requirement of entry and they are to be in the march-off assembly area well before the appointed time as advised in the appended notes to be issued with the draw of each competition. Bands are to follow directions from the contest supervisor or representatives including PBV marshals and the Senior Drum Major and his delegated assistants. The march-off and massed bands will commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise notified. Massed bands will not be delayed to include bands that may arrive late.

Bands are to assemble at the designated point, and marching individually past the dais in the order they compete for the "aggregate" contest. The gap between bands to be as instructed or no more than a minute. Number 1 & 2 bands to combine. Immediately clearing the dais or designated point, bands shall cease playing and proceed to the massed band assembly area.

Pipe Majors, Drum Sergeants and Drum Majors have a responsibility to ensure all players in their band are aware of tune requirements before entering the assembly area.
