BEGINNER – SNARE 2 parts of own choice March style music.

Played on a practice pad and must be accompanied by a piper on a practice chanter.

Competitor must have learnt snare drum for 12 months or less from the date of the first Contest in the season. Competitor will stay in this section for one season only.

Novice: Snare (Learner)

4 Parts of 2/4 March. (Can play 2 x 2 parts)

D Grade: Snare, Tenor & Bass (Elementary)

2 Parts of Hornpipe into 2 Parts of Jig

C Grade: Snare (Sub-Intermediate)

4 Parts of Hornpipe into 4 Parts of Jig (Can play 2 x 2 parts of each)

B Grade: Snare, Tenor & Bass (Intermediate)

4 Parts of Hornpipe into 4 Parts of Jig

A Grade: Snare, Tenor & Bass (Open)

March, Strathspey & Reel, each of 4 parts or more (Traditional Style)

All competitors are to commence their performance with two three paced rolls.
