The Award for outstanding services to the Pipe Band movement is presented annually at the Annual Ringwood Highland Games and recognised the first chieftain of the VHPBA from 1963 to 2004 - Sir Rupert Hamer AC, KCMG, ED. The award is the highest honour bestowed on a person by the VHPBA with the exception of Life Membership.

Nominees should be persons who have made a significant personal commitment in support of the objectives of Pipe Bands in Victoria and the VHPBA over many years. The nominees support can be as a musician, drum major, tutor, administrator, or a Combination.

Nominations are to be submitted by the Executive of the VHPBA or Bands member bands and should be signed by the President and Secretary or if necessary responsible Officers of the Band or the Association. The nomination should be supported by written references from at least THREE people who have been in a position to witness the contribution of the nominee for a suitable period.
