- c) The Promoter`s right to charge band members` families the normal gate fee. Band personnel must present their gate passes to gain entry to the ground. Passes will be sent direct to the Bands entered by the Promoter concerned;
- d) Participation in the Street March and/or March Off Drill Contest - where offered - irrespective they do not form part of the aggregate contest for all Grade 4 to 1 bands are compulsory contest elements. Failure to do so may well result in disqualification and/or the forfeiture of any eligible prize monies.
- e) The consumption of alcohol whilst forming, up for and during massed bands is prohibited until after the massed band has been dismissed by the Senior Drum Major. Attention is drawn to the requirements of Rule A.1.08.01 (acceptable behaviour).
